Moving Forward with a Fresh New Vision...

The community gave a great deal of feedback on the speed bumps installed earlier this year. Feedback indicates about half of the community want speed bumps and the other half do not. It further seems most residents agree that speeding is an issue and some mechanism to curb speeding is necessary. The Board understands the speed bumps themselves may not be an issue, but the surprise installation and lack of transparency is a serious concern. Additionally, the speed bumps were installed poorly and each of the 4 bumps is a different shape and size, providing Abernathy residents a different experience than Broyles. Lastly, in at least one location the speed bump is blocking storm water from reaching a street drain causing minor flooding.

The Board had planned a June asphalt re-sealing of the Holly Trace roadways. Concerns with hurricane season rain and an issue with the contractor's equipment postponed the re-sealing until October. In the interest of board transparency and community input, the board has decided to further delay the re-sealing until February/March. The additional time will the allow the board to collect community concerns regarding the speed bumps and how best to schedule the re-sealing work that aligns with the dry season and is the least invasive on community members, especially those with disabilities.

For the immediate future, it is the Board's intention to completely remove the existing speed bumps. The poor workmanship of the speed bumps, the issue with storm water, and the sealing of the roads warrant removal and will provide an opportunity for community input on future speed control measures and placement. The discussion of speed bump removal is on the August HOA meeting agenda, and we welcome your feedback and encourage everyone to attend the meeting. Once we have a plan for the road sealing and we have gotten significant community feedback to include a survey or vote, the community can decide if we install speed bumps, how many, and where or approve alternative plan to curb speeding.

HOA meetings are held at 6PM monthly on the third Tuesday in the clubhouse on Bramblewood Circle.
